## RULES FOR "A" HONOR ROLL OPEN CAMPUS

Students are encouraged to strive for high achievement in school. As an incentive and reward for those who do, high school students who are on the Superior or A honor roll have the privilege of leaving school during their study hall to go to the library or Rec Center (when they are open), home, or for an extended lunch period. The following rules must be followed:

1. This privilege is for students in grades 9 – 12.
2. A student must be on the Superior or A honor roll for the previous quarter.
3. This permission form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian at the beginning of each school year. Parents may revoke their child's permission at any time.
4. Students must maintain their A honor roll status. Teachers who indicate that the student's grades have fallen will have this privilege suspended until grades improve.
5. Permission may be revoked upon verified reports of unacceptable behavior while on or off school grounds.
6. Students must sign out with the study hall supervisor or the office, indicating their destination. The study hall supervisor and the office will have a list of all eligible students.
7. Students must return on time for their next class. Failure to do so will result in a four-week suspension of privilege. The exception to this requirement would be for students who have a study hall 7<sup>th</sup> hour. Those students are not required to return to school.
