- **6.** <u>Student Council Report</u>: Ryan Jorgenson and Rylee Lux reported on the successful ski trip, Health Week activities next week, Gibraltar invited the Washington Island students to attend prom, the Council is working on a Senior Prom for community members.
- 7. Principal's Report: Melanie Miller and Karin Baxter were recognized for successfully completing the highly qualified paraprofessionals via the CESA 7 program. Thank you. Jessica Dennis was invited to present at two State science teacher conferences. Miranda Dahlke will attend a Samsung teacher conference in New York City courtesy of Samsung Corporation in April. Mrs. kanipes nominated Donna Briesemeister for philanthropic recognition in the Peninsula Pulse. Mrs. Kanipes happily reported the District received a second place \$250 prize from the WI Retired Educators for of STEAM program. The STRIDE mental health services continue to want to work with the school and community to provide mental health services via virtual therapy if another building in the community has the connectivity for streaming. Gathering Grounds is hosting a school day for middle and high school students on May 22, the Trap Shooting team raised money and fostered goodwill in the community by shoveling snow for local residents, Mrs. Kanipes has a draft of the PI 26 Academic and Career Planning Plan for the Board to review.

- President's Report President Amy Jorgenson thanked the administrative staff for the great place the District is currently in. Evaluations are completed. She asked the Board to pick a date for board retreat.
- Budget Committee The committee discussed the IP phone system and decided to table voting on it, and the Going Garbage proposal for trash and recycling disposal.
- Employee Relation and Personnel Committee The committee is waiting to hear from the health insurance cooperative after bids from current health carrier increased 10%, continues to work on compensation models and evaluation tools for the future use. The committee is also working to update job descriptions for custodian, administrative assistant, paraprofessional, teachers, and coaching staff.

- Transportation / Building & Grounds Committee The committee looked over the shared services agreement proposals for the well with the Town of Washington, and the septic system with Recreation Center. LaForce installed interior door locks today and and will install outside door locks tomorrow. During Spring Break, Island Builders installed three windows in administration and student services offices for increased visual supervision. One sealed bid was received from Jackson Harbor Soup for the old van. Going Garbage proposed \$100/month for 6 cans.
- Referendum Committee The committee put out a second boxholder this weekend, and hopes community members vote on April 2. Also, any community member wishing to run as a write-in candidate needs to submit paperwork by March 29.
