Each commenter shall be identified by the commenter's name, place of residence, and whether the commenter has a student(s) currently enrolled in the District and/or is a staff person in the District. Comments must be directed solely to the Board and/or its designee and must not address other members of the audience during this part of the meeting. The Board, during the public comment period, will not discuss the agenda issues raised by the public commenter but may discuss such agenda items at the conclusion of the public comment period. All individuals who comment during the public comment period are reminded that the information provided this evening is intended to provide information to the Board so that it can fulfill its role. In receiving public comment, the Board encourages the commenter to engage in civil discourse that models character and ethical behavior. In that vein, all parties are reminded that all information offered is truthful and honest. False statements or stigmatizing charges may subject the individual making such statements to legal repercussions, including, but not limited to, defamation claims. Other specific procedures for the public comment period not mentioned herein can be found in Board Policy."*
