- With the suspension of in-person classes at the WISD, the staff and administration are asking for all 4K-12th grade parents, guardians or appointees to *pick up the alternative learning packages for their children from 2:30 pm – 3:30 pm this afternoon, March 18th. Please contact the district office if you need to make substitute plans for these items.*
- We will have all of these packets in the front of the school which will be delivered to your vehicle or assigned pick-up vehicle. We will also have Mr. Nikolai on site, as we are also allowing Chromebooks and headsets to be taken home for student use during the time we are not in the building. The WISD Acceptable Use Policy rules and regulations will remain in effect during this time. There will be a sign-out sheet that will need to be verified should you choose to take these items home. If your children have access a PC, laptop, Chromebook or another electronic device at home, you can opt to not take the district Chromebook(s) to your home.
- Teachers are also asking that parents-guardians do not throw away items that students brought home yesterday. Many of the items in these bundles include, but are not limited to notebooks, agendas, folders and paperwork that can be used during the March 30th – April 6th alternative learning time that the WISD has created to provide students and parents-guardians the opportunity to access remote educational services.
- Continued communication will be provided by the WI district office and/or staff regarding updates to this alternative learning plan. Again, students will have access to educational services after spring break. These services will commence on March 30th. We are resolved to make this situation as positive as we can.
