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Course Overview & Description:

Washington Island School is offering a 6-week Woodworking class. During the 6 weeks, you will have the opportunity to learn and explore the wood shop. Adult students will be able to learn and use the various tools and machines. Participants will have the opportunity to verify their woodworking skills so they can work independently or partake in an instructional step-by-step build.

The class will have instructional and safety elements at the beginning and then allow students to apply the learning-by-making and assembling their project. Instructors will be available to assist and ensure proper safety measures are being followed during the process.

All ability levels are welcome, prior woodworking skills will enhance your building process but are not necessary. This class is intended for Islanders who want to share ideas, learn new skills, refine existing skills, and walk away with a completed project.
